Year 11 Enrichment Days 2019-20

Throughout the academic year at King's, there are *Enrichment Days* on which the whole school is off timetable, participating in special events in school and educational visits. Below are the descriptions for the **Year 11** Enrichment Activities for the coming year. The approximate costs are voluntary contributions, however if we are unable to cover the cost of the visit/activity we will be unable to run the trip, and any payments already made will be refunded.

Please note that if your child is eligible for Free School Meals, or other funding, a reduced parental contribution is available for all curriculum activities if your child is FSM eligible.

Please also note that the costs on these trips are provisional, and may alter. Prices shown are always set to reflect the costs incurred by the school to provide events/activities

For the activity running in March, the balance is to be paid by **Friday 15th November 2019**. Please contact our finance team (finance@kingsschoolhove.org.uk) if you would not be able to pay this amount in time and would require a more bespoke payment plan.

Year 11 Enrichment day options- 2019-20

Friday 13th December 2019

Enterprise Day (all students)

During this day, students will work together in PR teams creating a fully costed, planned and promoted Year 11 prom. The teams will work on the costs of venue hire, decorations, entertainment, food, invitations and all other elements that go into planning large scale events.

Students will present their ideas to a panel, who will identify the winning bid. If possible, the winning presentation will then be used for the King's School Prom in July 2020.

This day gives the students an opportunity to experience real world finances, businesses and marketing. They will put their maths skills into practice, as well as their English language and teambuilding skills.

Monday 30th March 2020

Elevate (all students)

This will be a revision skills workshop provided by an external company, Elevate. We want to ensure that all year 11's approach their final exams with all the skills needed to succeed and this day will be an important part of their preparations.
