Year 11 Intervention 2020-21

I trust this letter finds you well. I am writing to explain some of the ways in which we will support your child/children through their Year 11 studies in the run up to their final GCSEs.

On **Wednesday 15th September 2021** we are running a Year 11 Information Evening with the aim of explaining to you some of the key milestones for Year 11 students in the academic year and the challenges they will face as they prepare for GCSEs. This will be an online event, running between 6 and 7pm and further information will be sent in due course from Mr Stevenson. Please keep this evening free in your diaries if you can.

Throughout the year your child/children may be invited to 'Period 7/8' classes which run in school Monday to Friday from 3:15-4:15pm. These classes offer targeted support to smaller groups of students to enable them to reach their target grades as they work towards their mock examinations in November and February, and the final examinations. You will be aware if your child is invited to Period 7/8 sessions and we would very much welcome your support in ensuring they attend.

We will also be running Year 11 sessions during half term breaks and holidays to ensure that we are taking every opportunity to help our students reach their potential. **During the 2021-22 academic year sessions will be run on the following dates: October 28th, October 29th, February 17th, February 18th, April 20th, April 21st, April 22nd, May 30th, May 31st, June 1st.** Whilst not all Year 11 students will be expected in school on all of these dates we would be grateful if you could keep them free so that students are available to attend any sessions they are invited to.

I hope this advance notice is helpful to you in making plans for the coming year. We are looking forward to continuing to work with you, in the best interests of your child/children, during this very important academic year.
