EXAMS INFORMATION



- Your form tutor has a mock timetable and seating plan and you have been given a personal timetable. Please familiarise yourself with these.
- You will be sitting your exams in the sports hall and geography room 4 on the second floor.
- Your personal timetables state your subject, the room you will be in for that exam and your seat number.
- For all exam papers you will be required to write your name and your candidate number.
- You must **NOT** write these until the invigilator asks you to fill them in.

CANDIDATE NUMBER

- Like the centre, each candidate is given a unique exam number. This is how examination boards know which exam script belongs to which candidate at a particular centre. Your candidate number allocated in year 10 will remain the same for your GCSE exams.
- Your unique candidate/exam number can be found on your examination timetable and will match an identification card on your exam desk.
- Please do not remove, move or deface this identification card. Having it on each desk during every exam is an exam board requirement.

TIMETABLE

- You have been given a timetable for your mock exams.
- You must check that:
 - Your personal details are correct
 - All of your subjects are listed on your timetable
 - You have a room and a seat listed for all exams
- If there are any errors or omissions please let your tutor know or speak with Mrs Lancaster.
