Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 11 written exams begin with Drama, tomorrow Friday 8th May. Before morning exams, a student briefing will take place from 8.30. For afternoon exams, we have planned a revision session with subject teachers during lesson 3 or 4. Departments are also running revision sessions after school on the afternoon before a morning exam.

Please see the attached timetable which outlines the timings and locations of all sessions. This information has been shared with all Year 11s and is available in their tutor rooms as a reminder. Links to the online sessions for RS and History will be emailed to the student's school email address.

The JCQ regulations around exams have been fully explained to students in an assembly this week. You can find a copy of the Exams Handbook on our school website [25-26 Exams Handbook.pdf](#). Morning exams start at 9.00am. Afternoon exams start at 1.30pm. These are the exam boards normal published start times.

Students have been reminded of the importance of being in school on time to start the exams. If an emergency has arisen which means that your young person is going to be late, please contact the school office as soon as possible to notify us. If your child is ill on the morning of an exam, consider very carefully whether they really cannot sit the paper(s) they have that day. In most circumstances it will be far better if they sit the exam. If they really cannot it is vital that you notify us before 8am by calling the school office on 01273 840004.

A reminder that students are expected to be in school every day over the next two weeks, whether they have an exam or not. When students are not in exams they will attend their timetabled lessons. Teachers will be leading focused revision sessions during these times. On Friday 22nd May only students taking the PE exam will be expected in; they will be free to leave site when their exam is finished.

We know how challenging the lead up to exams can be for young people. We are holding them in our prayers and ensuring that they are supported in school. If you are concerned about your young person at any point throughout the exam period, please don't hesitate to contact us.
