Year 11 Information

As your child moves into Year 11, I wanted to reach out to let you know about some upcoming events and details that may be useful for you.

Our Year 11 Prom this year will be on Thursday 9th of July at Pangdean Barn (Pangdean Farm, Brighton BN45 7FJ). We will be looking forward to sending the Year 11s off in style with a fun evening that will include a sit-down meal and music with plenty of dancing and celebration!

We are still finalising costs, but we estimate the price at approximately £60. We will confirm details of pricing and send through information in spring next year on how to pay and specific requirements. Students will not be permitted to drink alcohol at all during the event but will be able to purchase soft drinks from the bar.

Students engaging in poor behaviour, which is contrary to our ethos and values, may have their invitation retracted between now and the prom event. Should this happen, they will not be permitted entry to the Prom and monies already paid will be non-refundable; there will be no exceptions to this. Please note that any student found to be drinking alcohol, or under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances, or otherwise behaving inappropriately, will be asked to leave the event immediately and no refunds will be issued.

Also, we will be putting together a committee of students to help plan the Year 11 yearbook. This will contain memories and images of their time at Kings' School and will be available to purchase in the spring term for the approximate cost of £15.

We will also be selling Leavers' Hoodies in the spring term for an approximate cost of £25-£35. These will be given out just before the final exam period begins.
