### **Year 10 & 11 Theatre Trip 'Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time'**

The Drama department at King's has provisionally organised for 40 students to see '**Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time**' at **The Theatre Royal, New Road, Brighton, at 7.30pm on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2026.**

GCSE Drama students are required to see a live theatre performance as part of their course, in order to complete the second section of their written exam. This production is likely to provide ample discussion as preparation for this component, but this trip is optional at this stage of the course. There are 40 places in total, so it will be first come first served, with priority given to Year 11 (we will release a day early for these students).

King's School staff will meet students at the venue in central Brighton at 6.45pm. The performance is likely to end at about 10pm, so we would advise you to come at this time to collect your child. If you are happy for them to make their own way to and home from the venue, please make this clear on the ParentPay item. As this is a trip during the evening, students may wear their own clothes but must dress respectfully and sensibly.

**The contribution for this trip is £24, which includes the cost of the ticket and fees. Payment is via ParentPay, by 11<sup>th</sup> January 2026.**
