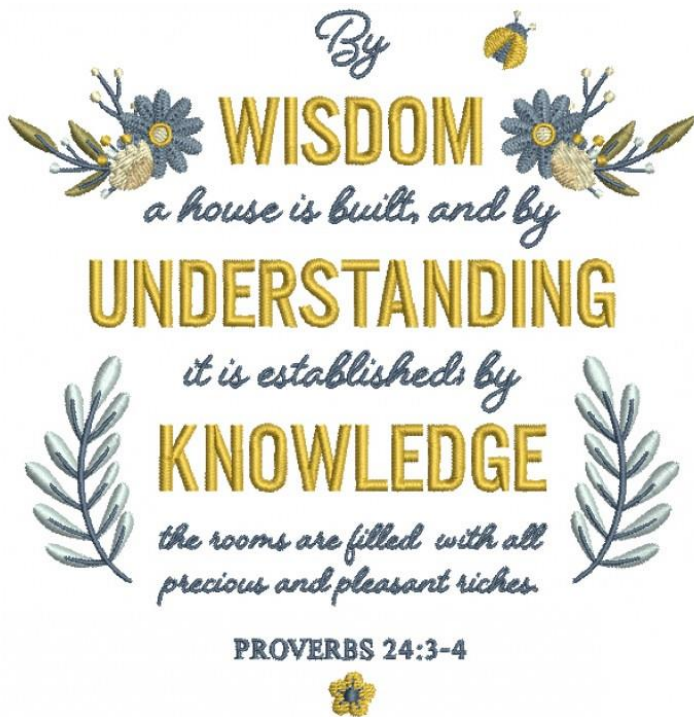


Theme of the Week: Creating a positive working environment - building

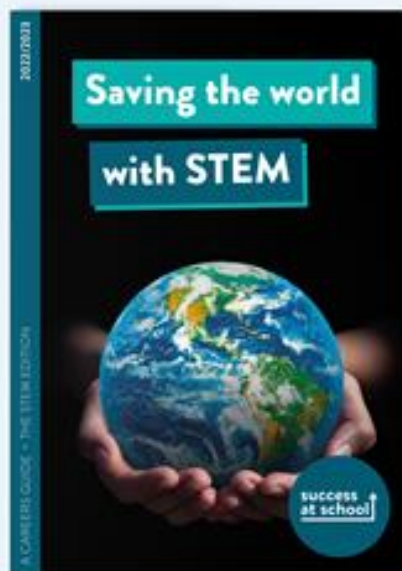
