

#### Scarlet Fever

If your child has symptoms of scarlet fever, please seek advice from your GP. Symptoms of scarlet fever are a high temperature, swollen glands and a rough sandpapery rash. Please see <u>NHS information here</u> for further details.

Siblings and close contacts of those with symptoms can continue to attend school unless they themselves become symptomatic. Children with scarlet fever can return to school 24 hours after beginning a course of antibiotics. All families are encouraged to remind their child of how to maintain good hand hygiene to prevent the spread of the infection.

#### Footwear and Nail Varnish

Please can you ensure that your child comes to school each day wearing appropriate school shoes. We have a helpful section of the school website which illustrates which shoes are permitted and which are not suitable for school. Please note that black leather Nike Trainers (see below) are not permitted and should not be worn to school. Pupils may only wear trainers if they have a letter from a GP or other medical professional stating that they must wear trainers in place of school shoes due to a current or ongoing medical condition.



We have also seen an increase in pupils coming to school wearing coloured nails/nail varnish. This is not permitted under the school's uniform policy and pupils will be asked to remove them. We would be grateful if you could check this ahead of your son/daughter coming to school.

#### Historian of the Fortnight!


