#### **Road Safety**

During the week commencing 30<sup>th</sup> September we will be speaking to all our students in assemblies on road safety. This is an issue that continues to concern us given the volume of traffic, bus stops, parking issues, drop-offs and layout of Hangleton Way. This week Mrs Price has again written to Brighton and Hove Council to urge them to take action, particularly in relation to having an effective crossing point.

As parents and carers, you can support us by ensuring that you do not park or drop off on the yellow zig zag lines. We have also placed signs on the pavement at the start and end of the day to discourage this. Please speak to your child about crossing the road safely, either by crossing with a member of duty staff at 3pm or walking down to the Primary School crossing point, denoted by a red painted square on the road.

Parents and carers of students in years 7 to 11 will have recently received communication regarding this, together with information from the Immunisation Service with details of how give or refuse consent for this vaccination.

The online consent form must be completed by 11am on **Wednesday 2nd October**, in order for a student to be included in the vaccination session at school on Monday 7th October.


#### Calling all parental musicians!
